<u>PROFILE</u>

Alyssa is a multidisciplinary artist, graduated from the DEC program of the National Circus School (Montreal, Quebec) in 2019, becoming the first student originating from the Canadian territories to graduate from the NCS. Throughout her childhood and youth she studied gymnastics, various styles of dance, movement improvisation, and theatre; which eventually merged into her circus practice. In 2015 Alyssa moved from her place of birth, Whitehorse, Yukon [Kwanlin Dün traditional territory] to Montreal, Quebec [Tiohtià:ke / Mooniyang], to pursue an education in circus arts. In 2017 Alyssa utilized three aerial hoops collectively, originating a novel aerial concept which she premiered internationally in Berlin, in 2023. Trained traditionally in Contortion, she employs her skills to evolve the discipline, through a conceptual and contemporary approach. Coexisting and intermingling with her performing arts practice, Alyssa is a self-taught poet and writer - her work has been published in international collections, as well as compiled in self-published poetry projects. Given her history of uprooting herself at a young age to pursue her passion, Alyssa is dedicated to bringing contemporary circus to the Yukon in the form of innovative, political, and thought provoking works. Alyssa is devoted to the unique potential of circus as an artistic language, and is passionate about using the medium to explore meaningful topics including feminist issues, substance dependency, spirituality, and the interconnectivity of all planetary beings.

Our Lady of the Home, 2024 - Ongoing

With support from the Canada Council for the Arts and the Yukon Arts Fund, Alyssa conceived and performed a 60 minute contemporary circus show employing contortion, physical theatre, acrobatics and aerial hoop to tell a feminist story of self-reclamation and authentic consent. Alyssa completed four creation residencies, nationally and internationally, and collaborated with diverse and acclaimed artists to bring the show to fruition. Paid an artist fee.

Circo Aereo, 2019 - 2023

Alyssa was engaged to work with Circo Aereo, pioneering and acclaimed Finnish/French contemporary circus company in 2019 following her graduation. Alyssa was selected at an international audition in Prague, CZ, to be one of seven artists in Circo Aereo's new creation, In_Between. Alyssa has participated in several residencies with the

company from 2020 to 2023 and is the only employed artist from North America. She has performed the show In_Between 150 times to international audiences. This is a paid engagement.
